Conditions of Entry

1. Owners of horses participating on Parade Day must have own indemnity insurance. Horse owners please attach proof of indemnity insurance with entry form.
2. The Kyneton Daffodil & Arts Festival to accept or reject entries.
3. It is the entrant's responsibility to ensure that all traffic regulations are adhered to, as specified by the Victoria Police.
4. The vehicles in the parade must travel at a safe speed, but not exceeding 20km/h.
5. Suitable arrangements are to be made to ensure that people in the load carrying area are prevented from falling off the vehicle.
6. Where there are children on the load area of a vehicle, a sufficient number of adults must be in the load carrying area of that vehicle to supervise the children.
7. No-one is to get on or off the load area of the vehicle while it is in motion, and nothing is thrown from persons on the load carrying area of the vehicle while the vehicle is in motion.
8. It is the entrant's responsibility to ensure the security of the entry at all times.
9. It is the entrant's responsibility to ensure the safety of the design of the entry. This includes any type of construction, and the erection of any scaffolding structure on the entry, and the safety and condition of materials used. The entrant must further ensure that the entry is capable of carrying the number of people nominated in the entry form.
10. Under no circumstances may alcohol be consumed or distributed on any entry in the parade.
11. Direction given by the Parade Director, and/or the marshals before, during or after the parade **MUST BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT DISPUTE.**
12. The Kyneton Daffodil and Arts Festival Inc. reserves the right to order the removal of signs, banners, or any material or person considered offensive by the police or the organisers.
13. The Kyneton Daffodil & Arts Festival Inc. accepts no responsibility for damages to entries, or loss or damage to personal property, or injury to personnel or animals associated with the entry before, during or after the parade.
14. Noise from sirens and vehicles must be kept to a minimum.
